As part of this visit, the children will be taking part in an immersive learning experience linked to our topic on **the Romans**. To help bring history to life, we would like the children to come to school dressed as **Romans**.



Simple costume ideas include:

- ✓ A plain white T-shirt or tunic
- ✓ A white sheet or fabric draped as a toga (optional)
- ✓ A belt or rope tied around the waist
- ✓ Sandals or sturdy shoes
- ✓ A laurel wreath headband (optional)



Please do not feel that you need to buy a costume—using items that you already have at home is absolutely fine. The costume can also be worn again for our **Entry or Exit Curriculum Points**, so it will be used for more than one special occasion.

During our visit to the library, the children will:

- Listen to a story linked to our Romans topic.
- Explore a range of books from this genre.
- Take part in a themed craft activity.



As this is a unique opportunity, photographs will be taken during the visit and may be shared with the **local press** to celebrate the children's learning and our partnership with the library. These photographs will be used in line with the school's existing photo permission procedures.

This visit will provide a wonderful opportunity for the children to develop their love of reading while deepening their understanding of life in Roman Britain.
